Information about MassHealth HCBS Waivers

Acquired Brain Injury (ABI) Waivers and Moving Forward Plan (MFP) Waivers

Home and Community Based Services (HCBS) waivers are MassHealth programs that provide services to eligible members in their own homes or community. Massachusetts has four HCBS waivers that serve adults who move from a nursing facility, chronic disease and rehabilitation hospital, or psychiatric hospital back to the community. There is a maximum number of participants who can be served each year.

1. ABI-RH Waiver <i>Acquired Brain Injury with Residential Habilitation</i> operated by Dept. of Developmental Services	Adults with Acquired Brain Injury (ABI) who need 24- hour supervision in a provider-operated and staffed residence	
2. ABI-N Waiver <i>Acquired Brain Injury Non-residential Habilitation</i> operated by MassAbility	Adults with ABI who do not need 24-hour supports/ supervision, but need community-based waiver services provided in their home	
3. MFP-RS Waiver <i>Moving Forward Plan Residential Supports</i> operated by Dept. of Developmental Services	Adults who need 24-hour supervision in a provider- operated and staffed residence	
4. MFP-CL Waiver <i>Moving Forward Plan Community Living</i> operated by MassAbility	Adults who do not need 24-hour supports and supervision, but need community-based waiver services provided in their home

- * Some examples of ABIs that qualify are brain injuries resulting from **stroke, brain trauma, infection of the brain, brain tumor, or anoxia**. Dementia-type conditions do not qualify.
- ** Financial requirements for HCBS waiver applicants
 - o Income ≤ 300% of the SSI Federal Benefit Rate (\$2,901 per month in 2025)
 - o **Countable assets** \leq \$2,000
 - o **Countable assets** of applicant's spouse (if applicable) \leq \$ 157,920 (in 2025)
