Information is obtained from data entered in the MA DOC's Inmate Management System and is compiled by the Research and Planning Division. Operational capacity includes general population bed capacity within each facility. This does not include beds utilized for discipline, investigations, infirmary or any other support beds used for special purposes.

\*Demographics are reported for the total facility count; sentence information for criminally sentenced population only.

\*\*Institutional length of stay (LOS) is the number of days between January 1, 2025 and the most recent transfer date to the given facility or the most recent break in custody. Temporary visits to hospitals, courts or temporary holds are not considered a break in custody. This represents the average number of days an inmate has been housed in the noted facility as of January 1, 2025.
