

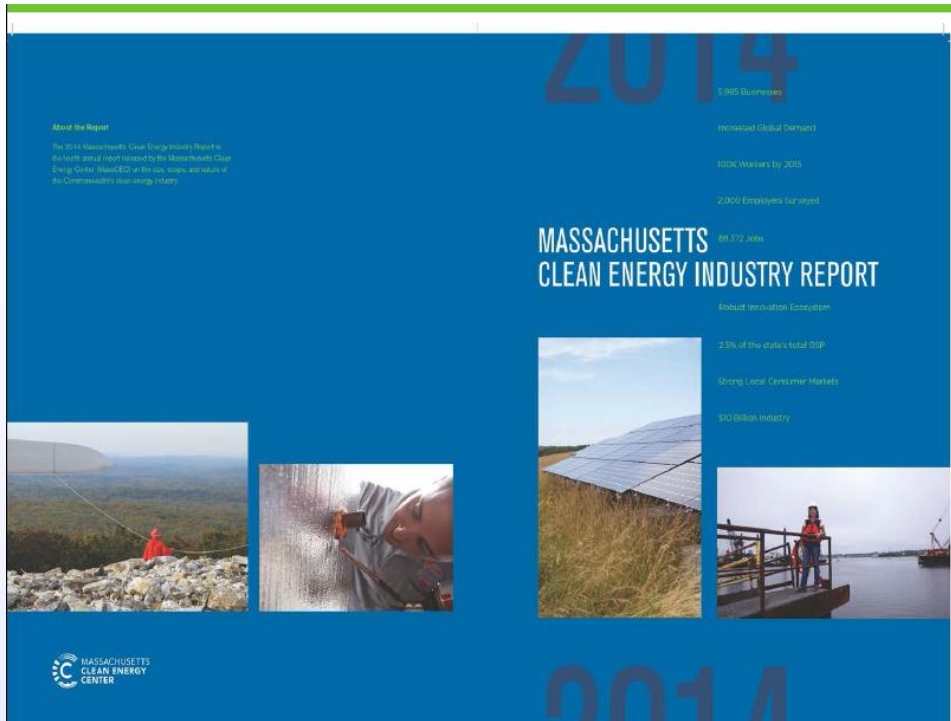

88,372 jobs

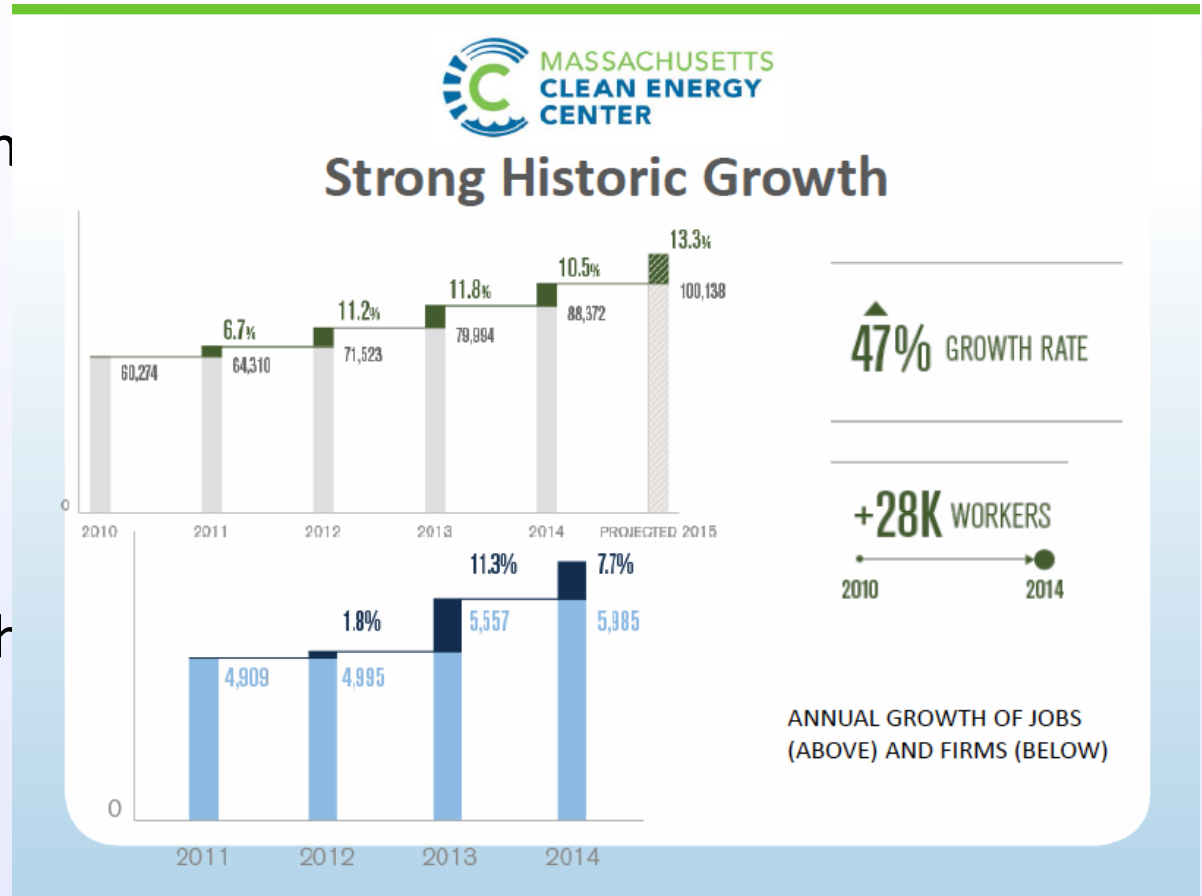
2.4% of total Massachusetts workforce

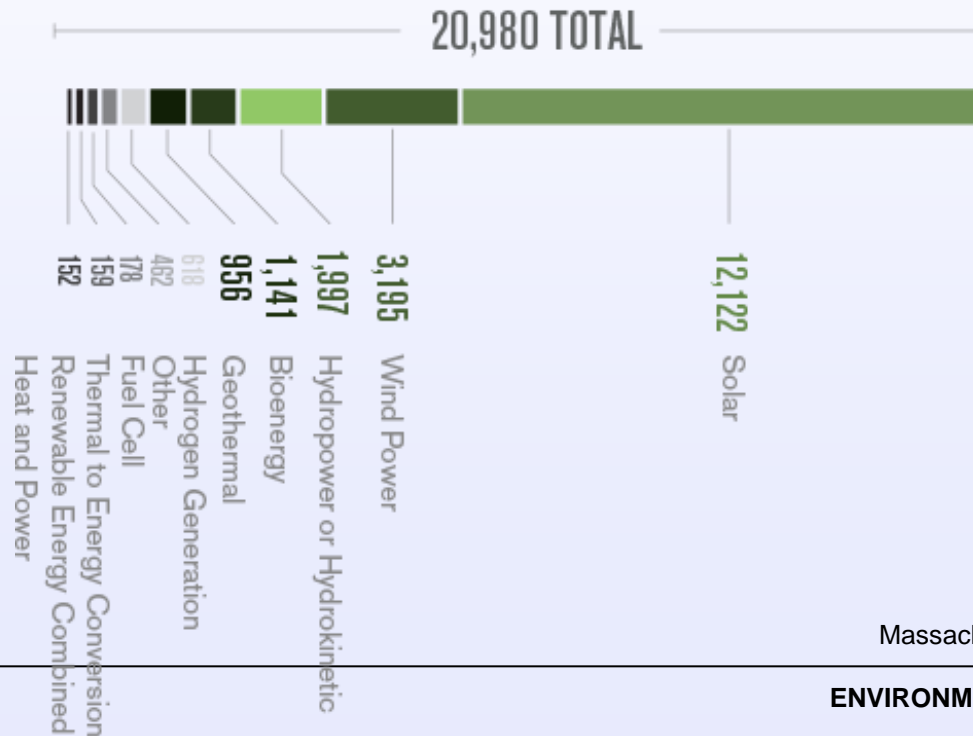
