"Municipal Program"

- For incentives, all Municipal Customers must go through our C & I -Commercial & Industrial Program (no more SBS or Direct Install)
- All PEXs can and do participate in Municipal Projects
- PEX's role in coordinating with National Grid Rep
- Emphasis on "Comprehensiveness" (what's that?)
- Custom Applications
 - Must pass benefit/cost test; requires analysis
- Incentive Rates
 - \$0.25 per annual kWh savings, typical but negotiable up or down
 - \$1.50 per annual Therm saved; also typical/negotiable

Municipal Program (cont.)

- TA Assistance
 - 100% cost, up to \$7500 if you move on a project
 - Put another way, cost is shared up front but is waived if you implement some or all recommendations (prevents "free audit effect")
 - Lighting Audits Excluded (PEX's could/would do)
 - Once the walk-through is complete, any contractor, PEX or otherwise, can come in to implement the recommendations
 - More flexibility with Muni's

Application Process

- Assumes you have an EE Project lined up!
- All apps on MassSave Site www.masssave.com
- 2 Types of Projects: Electric and Natural Gas
- 2 types of apps: Retrofit & New Construction
- 2 types of each app: Prescriptive & Custom
- Every App must be submitted as a package, including:
 - Front Page: Customer Signature, acct #, Sqft., Tax ID
 - "Cutsheets"
 - W-9 Info (for Fed Tax ID)

Application Process (cont.)

- App entered in work management system > App #
- Tech Analysis performed
- Pre-Inspection possible (vs. referring to code for NC)
- Commitment letter
 - Standard, or
 - "OBR" which must also be signed
- Project Begins!
- Upon Completion and Post-Inspection, Incentive Paid

Common Application Pitfalls

- If you know them, you can avoid them!
 - These will put the brakes on any processing; incentive payment:
 - No Signature
 - Or wrong location for signature...
 - Contractor must also sign when getting the incentive, and provide their
 W-9 Info
 - No acct # or wrong acct #
 - Great short cut here: >: Meter Number
 - No Square Footage entered
 - No Federal Tax ID / W-9 info
 - No pertinent email address (this is a real help)
 - Wrong or bad Phone Number (cell numbers are best, right?)

Common Application Pitfalls (cont.)

- Cut Sheet Troubles
 - "Info Blasts" or Info not identified
 - Keep support docs pertinent to project
- Technical Analysis is incomplete (Custom Apps)
 - > Biggest Hurdle
 - Doesn't show or prove savings
 - Use Custom Lighting Tool for Lighting Projects
- Invoice Troubles
 - Should represent Material & Labor > for project




