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## MassDEP's Official Answers to Questions Regarding the Ipswich Basin Grant Agency Document #: BWR 2024-01-WMA-Ipswich Basin

**December 22, 2023** 

On December 1, 2023, the Massachusetts Department of Environmental Protection (MassDEP) posted a grant Request for Responses (RFR) for the Ipswich Basin Grant. In accordance with the deadlines set forth in the RFR's grant procurement calendar, MassDEP accepted written questions via email through the December 19, 2023 deadline.

MassDEP's Official Answers to Questions that were received by the deadline are presented below.

- Q2. Are recipients of this award ineligible for other grant or SRF programs?
- A2. While the program cannot speak to all grant programs, recipients of the award would be eligible for SRF grant funds as long as the funds are not "double funding" the same costs.
- Q3. I'm noticing more language in grant documents urging collaboration with watershed organizations. Please confirm that collaboration is not a required element for eligibility.
- A3. Please review the language in the RFR on pages 7 and 11 regarding collaboration. Collaboration is encouraged, not required.
- Q4. Can one entity submit multiple proposals?
- A4. Yes, a single entity can submit multiple proposals.
- Q5. Can we start the project before the February 28, 2024 start-date and get reimbursed for expenses incurred before February 28<sup>th</sup>?
- A5. A new project cannot start prior to the required contracts being completed. In the case of work that has been completed between June 30, 2023 and the contract start date, reimbursement will not happen until the required contracts are signed.
