2017 ISSC Proposals FDA Non-concurrence

 Proposal 11-103 Alternative Male-specific Coliphage Meat Standard for Restricted Classification of Growing Areas Impacted by Wastewater Treatment Plant Outfall

FDA RESPONSE

- FDA did not concur with Conference action. As written the Model Ordinance language could be interpreted as optional.
- ISSC Executive Board voted to refer this proposal back to committee for clarification and to encourage States with depuration programs to pilot the use of MSC in classification for depuration harvesting.
- Proposal 17-100 Marina Definition

FDA RESPONSE

- FDA agreed with Conference action to refer this proposal to a committee. It is the position of FDA that mooring areas should be assessed as a potential pollution source.
- The committee is currently discussing draft language for defining mooring areas. The draft language includes criteria for assessing mooring areas.
- Proposal 17-217 Removal of Harvester Tags from Shellstock Containers

FDA RESPONSE

- FDA did not concur with Conference action and recommended alternative language
- ISSC Executive Board voted to refer the proposal back to committee for further consideration.

2017 ISSC Proposals FDA Non-concurrence

Proposal 17-305 Responsibilities of the FDA in the Evaluation of States

FDA RESPONSE

- FDA concurred with Conference action but believes state evaluation procedures should not be included in the Model Ordinance, but should instead be included in the FDA compliance program or in the ISSC Constitution, Bylaws and Procedures.
- Proposal 15-212 Dealer Record Retention

FDA RESPONSE

• FDA submitted this proposal and after conference adoption realized that the requirement was inconsistent with existing federal regulations. FDA requested that this change not be included in the 2017 NSSP Guide
