CONSENT AGREEMENT


The Board of Registration in Pharmacy ("Board") and Jackson K. Yu, R.Ph. ("Registrant"), a pharmacist registered by the Board (Pharmacist Registration No. 22170), do hereby stipulate and agree that the following information shall be entered into and become a permanent part of the file of the Registrant which is maintained by the Board:


1. The parties enter into this Consent Agreement ("Agreement") to resolve matters pending against the Registrant before the Board as Docket No. PH-08-014 (the "Complaint").
2. Registrant's acknowledges and agrees that the Complaint relates to the discipline of Registrant's pharmacist license (No. 15169) by the Nevada State Board of Pharmacy (Nevada Board) pursuant to that certain *Order* dated August 9, 2007. The Nevada Board found Registrant had violated multiple state statutes and regulations concerning his conduct as verifying pharmacist involved in a medication error (TPN) occurring on November 9, 2006 at Summerlin Hospital Medical Center Pharmacy, Las Vegas, Nevada. After a hearing involving multiple parties, the Nevada Board ordered Registrant to pay a \$2,500 administrative fine and his pharmacist license suspended for thirty days (August 22 - September 21, 2007).
3. Accordingly, the Registrant acknowledges and agrees to the following:
 - a. That his conduct as described in Paragraph 2 above warrants disciplinary action by the Board for conduct in violation of G.L. c. 112, s. 61 and 247 CMR 9.01(1); and
 - b. That his pharmacist license is hereby **SUSPENDED** by the Board for a thirty (30) day period; commencing as of the effective date of this Agreement.
4. The Agreement and its contents shall become a part of the records maintained by the Board, and as such, are public records subject to disclosure to the public, other licensing boards, and the National Association of Boards of Pharmacy.
5. In consideration of Registrant's execution of this Agreement, the Board will not advance the prosecution of the Registrant pursuant to the Complaint; any and all of his rights of the Board to take action within the scope of its authority are expressly reserved.

6. The Registrant understands and agrees that his decision to enter into this Agreement and to accept the terms and conditions herein described is a final act and is not subject to reconsideration or judicial review.

7. The Registrant states that he has used legal counsel in connection with his decision to enter into this Agreement or, if he did not, that he had an opportunity to do so and that his decision to enter into this Agreement was made of his own free will.

8. Registrant certifies that he has read this document entitled "Consent Agreement". The Registrant understands that, by executing this Agreement, he is waiving his right to a formal hearing at which he would possess the rights to confront and cross-examine witnesses, to call witnesses, to present evidence, to testify on his own behalf, to contest the allegations, to present oral argument, to appeal to the court in the event of an adverse ruling, and all other rights set forth in the State Administrative Procedure Act, G.L. c. 30A, and the Standard Adjudicatory Rules of Practice and Procedure, 801 CMR 1.01 et seq.


