• Agency strategies must¹:

- proactively promote EJ in all neighborhoods,
- appropriately integrate EJ considerations into departments through policies, programs, or other strategies,
- identify and promote agency sponsored projects, funding decisions, rulemakings or other actions to further EJ through the Commonwealth,
- demonstrate the fair distribution of benefits has been measured,
- be consolidated into one Secretariat EJ Strategy, and
- be finalized by a date set by the Secretary.

- Agency Senior staff collaborated with EJTF members on strategies

• Spring 2021 focus sessions

- Held in March, April & May
- Public comments received were recorded and posted on EEA EJ Webpage
- Comprehensive comments from stakeholders on a variety of concerns

• Agency-specific aspects:

- Examples include, but are not limited to:
 - Specific grants
 - Enforcement obligations
 - Cumulative impact analysis when required
 - Technical assistance opportunities
