Entry Requirements:

- Minimum of 17 years of age
- Physically capable of performing the work
- High School Diploma, GED or Equivalent
- Successfully pass a drug test
- Consent to a background check Massachusetts CORI
- Driver's license and reliable transportation

Apprenticeship Terms

- Four weeks of full-time "pre-job" Training is required for all selected applicants to be held at BAC Boston Training Center. Only after completing the pre-job training will an individual be initiated into the union as an apprentice and be placed on a job site.
- Five Thousand (5,000) hours of on the job learning/training
- The first one thousand (1,000) hours are probationary
- Weekly related training class (150 hours per year)
