TASK FORCE UPDATE:

SPRING 2022:

Superintendent Matton updated the Commission on spring aerial larvicide plans. While multiple projects are scheduled, the Project is still establishing if all the work can be conducted successfully. Further conversation with North Fork Helicopters and MPAL was done by Mr. Duval and is in place. Mr. Duval will be contacting people in academia for proposals regarding *Ae. albopictus* establishment. Chair Barile asked to be updated on supply chain concerns this season.
