

1. Your surrender of your pharmacy technician registration together with any right to renew your registration, to the Board, effective May 4, 2007, was voluntary;
2. Your surrender of your pharmacy technician registration is an act which deprives you of all privileges of registration and is not subject to reconsideration or judicial review;
3. You will not apply or attempt to be registered as a pharmacy technician or to renew any pharmacy technician registration issued by the Commonwealth of Massachusetts at any time in the future.

If you do not agree to the terms and conditions listed above as the terms and conditions by which the Board has accepted the surrender of your pharmacist technician registration in resolution of Complain Docket No. PH-07-099, you must notify the Board in writing at the address above within 21 days of the date of this as letter.

Please be advised that the Board will close the complaint based on your surrender of your pharmacist technician registration on the terms and conditions listed above in the event you have not otherwise notified the Board by the date noted herein.
