Massachusetts Acts of 2010 Chapter 58 Section 10B. Notwithstanding chapter 150E of the General Laws or any other general or special law to the contrary, a collective bargaining agreement entered into by the city or the school department after the effective date of this act shall be subject to the approval of the overseer or finance control board is in effect at the time. No collective bargaining agreement shall be approved under this section unless the overseer or finance control board provides written certification to the secretary that after an evaluation of all pertinent financial information reasonably available, the city's financial resources and revenues are, and will continue to be, adequate to support such collective bargaining agreement without a detrimental impact on the continuous provision of the existing level of municipal services. A decision, by the overseer or finance control board, to disapprove of a collective bargaining agreement under this section shall be made in a report to the parties; provided, however, that the report shall specify the disapproved portions of the agreement and the supporting reasons for the disapproval.
