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#### **OPEN SESSION**

Chairman Hanson called the meeting to order at 11:05 A.M.

### Chairman's Report:

Chairman Hanson reported that the vice chair position vacancy has been posted and that he will be contacting the three chairs to schedule interviews with three candidates identified to date. Additional interviews will be scheduled as necessary. There was a general discussion of the interview process and candidates that have been identified to date. Chairman Hanson will proceed to schedule this matter.

Mr. Morgado briefed the Committee and reported that the parties had reached a settlement among themselves, and that the tentative agreement would now be subject to Town Meeting action.

Motion by M. Reddy, seconded by Goldsmith: to move Case No. JLM-22-9336 – Fairhaven Fire to Awaiting Funding

The Motion passed unanimously.

2. JLM-22-9646 Milford Fire JOEH, DJM Vote to a 3(a) Hearing

Mr. Morgado briefed the Committee and reported that there have been two staff level and one committee level mediation that have yielded no agreement to date despite the best efforts of the parties. The assigned Committee members Robert Green and Kathleen Johnson were recommending that a 3(a) hearing be scheduled. Additional mediation will take place at this 3(a) hearing.

Motion by Mazzarella, seconded by M. Reddy: that the Committee find that in the matter of Milford Firefighters Local 2140, IAFF and the Town of Milford – JLM-22-9646 the issues hearing pursuant to Section 1, subsection 3(a), as set forth in Chapter 589 of the Acts of have remained unresolved for an unreasonable period of time resulting in the apparent exhaustion of the process of collective bargaining, and that the Committee vote to hold a 1987, with the panel members consisting of Robert Green (Labor) and Kathleen Johnson (Management), or other Committee members and/or senior staff that may be substituted as necessary by the respective Labor and/or Management Chairs pursuant to the rules, policies, and procedures of the Committee, and any other applicable provisions of law, with said panel to be chaired by John Hanson.

3. JLM-22-9278 Beverly Police DC, DJM Move to Awaiting Funding

Mr. Morgado advised that the tentative agreement that was reported at the last meeting of the Committee has now been funded and that the case may now be removed.
