Chairman Hanson called the meeting to order at 11:10 A.M.

Chairman's Report:

Chairman Hanson reported that the Senate Ways and Means Committee had restored the JLMC's budget to last year's amount of \$300,000 after some \$8500.00 had been cut in the Governor's budget. Chairman Hanson recognized the efforts of MassCop, MMA and the PFFM in restoring the budget.

Chairman Hanson discussed data problems in the case management system that potentially exposed non-public information to public disclosure. Chairman Hanson mentioned that the problem was being fixed and that the non-public information has been taken down. He also mentioned that a new petition form was being circulated. Mr. Reddy wanted to make sure that the non-public information was being taken down. Mr. Hanson told the Committee to let him know if they find anything else.
