• Chairman's Report:

Chairman Hanson said that the JLMC budget is set at \$350,000 in the Senate and is now in conference committee.

1. JLM-24-10461 East Bridgewater DC/RM Jurisdiction

Bob Markel briefed the Committee and, based upon the investigation, recommended that the Committee take jurisdiction.

Motion by Mazzarella, seconded by Andrews: to take jurisdiction in the case of East Bridgewater Police Association and Town of East Bridgewater, JLM-24-10461.

The Motion passed unanimously.

2. JLM-24-10585 Taunton Fire GD/JH Jurisdiction

Joe Hubley briefed the Committee and, based upon the investigation, recommended that the Committee take jurisdiction.

Motion by Mazzarella, seconded by Cross: to take jurisdiction in the case of Taunton Firefighters, Local 138 and City of Taunton, JLM-24-10585.

The Motion passed unanimously.

Motion by Mazzarella, seconded by Cross: to assign the following Committee Members to the case of Taunton Firefighters, Local 138 and City of Taunton, JLM-24-10585: Mazzarella (Management) and Green (Labor) or substitutes as so designated by the Management and Fire Chairs respectively.

3. JLM-24-10599 Sharon Fire GD/JH Jurisdiction

Joe Hubley briefed the Committee and, based upon the investigation, recommended that the Committee take jurisdiction.

Motion by Cross, seconded by Mazzarella: to take jurisdiction in the case of Sharon Firefighters, Local 1880 and Town of Sharon, JLM-24-10599.

The Motion passed unanimously.

Motion by Cross, seconded by Mazzarella: to assign the following Committee Members to the case of Sharon Firefighters, Local 1880 and Town of Sharon, JLM-24-10599: Mazzucco (Management) and Cross (Labor) or substitutes as so designated by the Management and Fire Chairs respectively.

The Motion passed unanimously.

4. JLM-23-10130 Everett Patrol DC/GD Tentative Agreement

George Driscoll reported that, after two staff level mediations, the parties were close and, at the suggestion of staff, continued to talk and finally reached agreement. The agreement needs to be ratified. No action necessary.

5. JLM-23-10400 Hudson Fire RM/JH Vote to a 3(a) Hearing

Motion by Cross, seconded by Mazzarella: that, in the matter of Hudson Fire Fighters, Local 1713 and Town of Hudson, JLM-23-10400, the issues have remained unresolved for an unreasonable period of time resulting in the apparent exhaustion of the process of collective bargaining, and that the Committee vote to hold a hearing pursuant to Section 1, subsection 3(a) of the Acts of 1987, with panel members consisting of Papagni (Labor) and Vecchio (Management) or other Committee members and/or senior staff that may be substituted as necessary by the respective Labor and/or Management Chairs pursuant to the rules, policies, and procedures of the Committee, and any other applicable provisions of law, with said panel to be chaired John Hanson.

The Motion passed unanimously.
