Joe Hubley briefed the Committee and reported that the parties had reached agreement and that the contract has been funded by the town.

Motion by Mazzarella, seconded by Cross: to remove the case from the Committee's docket as the contract has been funded by the Town.

2. JLM-23-9769 Chelmsford Fire JOEH, GD Tentative Agreement

Joe Hubley briefed the Committee and reported a tentative agreement at mediation.

3. JLM-23-9917 Watertown Fire JOEH, GD Vote to 3(a) Hearing

Joe Hubley briefed the Committee.

Motion by Cross, seconded by Mazzarella: to find that in the matter of the Watertown Firefighters, IAFF Local 1347 and the City of Watertown, JLM-9917, the issues have remained unresolved for an unreasonable period of time resulting in the apparent exhaustion of the process of collective bargaining, and that the Committee vote to hold a hearing pursuant to Section 1, subsection 3(a), as set forth in Chapter 589 of the Acts of 1987, with the panel members consisting of Green (Labor) and Hayes (Management), or other Committee members and/or senior staff that may be substituted as necessary by the respective Labor and/or Management Chairs pursuant to the rules, policies, and procedures of the Committee, and any other applicable provisions of law, with said panel to be chaired by John Hanson.

The Motion passed unanimously.

4. JLM-23-10040 New Bedford Police DC, DM Tentative Agreement

Tim Gibney announced that he was leaving the meeting and took no part in the consideration or discussion of this item.

Don Cummings briefed the Committee and reported that the parties reached a tentative agreement during mediation.

5. JLM-23-10041 Haverhill Fire JOEH, GD Vote on Jurisdiction

Motion by Cross, seconded by Mazzarella: to take jurisdiction in the case of the Haverhill Firefighters, Local 1011, and the City of Haverhill, JLM-23-10041.
