OPEN SESSION

Chairman Hanson called the meeting to order at 11:05 A.M.

The Chair made some general opening comments and greetings and advised that the meeting was being recorded. The Chair called the roll of those present.

Chairman Hanson apprised the Committee that we are receiving more cases and that we are busy. He noted that solutions are becoming hard to find and that we have a lot of 3(a) hearings scheduled.

Mr. M.Reddy introduced the new Fire member, Rob Green of the Lexington Fire Department. Chairman Hanson welcomed Mr. Green to the Committee.

1. JLM-22-9393 Holyoke Police DC, DJM Vote on Jurisdiction

Mr. Cummings briefed the Committee.

Motion by Andrews, seconded by Mazzarella: to take jurisdiction in the case of the Holyoke Police Patrol IBPO Local 388 and the City of Holyoke, JLM-22-9393.

The Motion passed unanimously.

Motion by Andrews, seconded by Mazzarella: to assign the following Committee members to the case of the Holyoke Police Patrol IBPO Local 388 and the City of Holyoke, JLM-22-9393: Pedrini/Andrews for Police and Dean Mazzarella for Management or substitutes as so designated and approved by the Police and Management Chairs respectively.

2. JLM-22-9197 Fall River Fire

JOEH, DJM Vote to Arbitration

Mr. Morgado briefed the Committee.

Motion by Mazzarella, seconded by M. Reddy: to find that in the matter of the Fall River Firefighters Local 1314 IAFF and the City of Fall River, JLM-22-9197, that there is an apparent exhaustion of the processes of collective bargaining which constitutes a potential threat to public welfare and that the Committee vote to send this case to arbitration by a tripartite panel consisting of David Keene (Labor) and Gerard Hayes (Management)) and/or other Committee members and/or senior staff that may be substituted as necessary by the respective Labor and/or Management Chairs pursuant to the rules, policies, and procedures of the Committee, and any other applicable provisions of law, and a neutral selected in accordance with the Committee's rules, policies and procedures, on an issue by issue basis, with said issues having been identified at the September 29, 2022, hearing held pursuant to Section 1, Subsection 3(a), of Chapter 589 of the Acts of 1987.

The Motion passed unanimously.

• Vote to accept the following minutes of hearings held pursuant to Section 1, subsection (3)(a) of Chapter 589 of the Acts of 1987 (Provided quorum of panel members are present).
