Chairman Hanson called the meeting to order at 11:05 A.M.

The Chair made some general opening comments and greetings and advised that the meeting was being recorded. The Chair called the roll of those present.

• Administrative updates:

Vote to accept the full Committee meeting minutes from October 13, 2022.

Motion by Mazzarella, seconded by M.Reddy: to accept the minutes from the Committee meeting on October 13, 2022, as presented.

The Motion passed unanimously.

• Chairman's Report:

Chairman Hanson reported that Yarmouth Police Chief and alternate management member Frank Frederickson is retiring on October 31, 2022, and thanked him for his fine work on the Committee.

• Review and Act on the following Petition, Jurisdiction and Awaiting Funding List (AFL) Cases:

1. JLM-21-8708 Lexington Police DC, GD Move to Awaiting Funding

Mr. Driscoll briefed the Committee and reported that, after several staff and committee level mediations, the parties were able to reach agreement and had fully ratified an MOA. The contract is expected to go before town meeting for funding in November.

Motion by Pedrini, seconded by Mazzarella: to move the case to Awaiting Funding.

The Motion passed unanimously.

2. JLM-21-8839 West Springfield Police DC, GD Move to Awaiting Funding

Mr. Driscoll briefed the Committee and reported that, after four staff level mediations, the parties were able to reach agreement and had fully ratified an MOA. The contract is expected to go before the Council for funding in November.

Motion by Mazzarella, seconded by Pedrini: to move the case to Awaiting Funding.

The Motion passed unanimously.

3. JLM-22-9160 Freetown Police DC, GD Funded/Remove

Mr. Cummings briefed the Committee and reported that, after several staff and committee level mediations, the parties reached agreement and fully ratified an MOA. The contract was funded by town meeting on October 18, 2022.

Motion by Mazzarella, seconded by Pedrini: to remove the case from the Committee's docket as the contract has been funded by Town Meeting.

The Motion passed unanimously.

4. JLM-22-9269 H	Holyoke Fire	JOEH, DJM	Vote to Arbitration
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Mr. Morgado briefed the Committee.

Motion by M.Reddy, seconded by Mazzarella: to find that in the matter of the Holyoke Firefighters Local 1693 IAFF and the City of Holyoke, JLM-22-9269, that there is an apparent exhaustion of the processes of collective bargaining which constitutes a potential threat to public welfare and that the Committee vote to send this case to arbitration by a tripartite panel consisting of David Keene (Labor) and William Mahoney (Management)) and/or other Committee members and/or senior staff that may be substituted as necessary by the respective Labor and/or Management Chairs pursuant to the rules, policies, and procedures of the Committee, and any other applicable provisions of law, and a neutral selected in accordance with the Committee's rules, policies and procedures, on an issue by issue basis, with said issues having been identified at the October 24, 2022, hearing held pursuant to Section 1, Subsection 3(a), of Chapter 589 of the Acts of 1987.

The Motion passed unanimously.

5. JLM-16-5509 Chelmsford Police Superiors DC, GD Funded/Remove

Mr. Driscoll briefed the Committee and reported that the arbitration award had been funded by the Chelmsford Town Meeting on October 3, 2022.

Motion by Mazzarella, seconded by Pedrini: to remove the case from the Committee's docket as the arbitration award has been funded by Town Meeting.

The Motion passed unanimously.
