OPEN SESSION

Chairman Hanson recognized that a quorum was present and called the meeting to order at 11:07 A.M. The Meeting was recorded.

The Chair made some general opening comments and greetings.

Administrative updates:

Vote to accept the full Committee meeting minutes from June 27, 2024.

Motion by Mazzarella, seconded by Andrews: to accept the minutes from the full Committee meeting on June 27, 2024, as presented.

The Motion passed unanimously.

Chairman's Report:

Chairman Hanson said that the JLMC budget is set at \$350,000 in the Senate and is still in conference committee.

Review and Act on the following Petition, Jurisdiction and Awaiting Funding List (AFL) Cases

1. JLM-23-10061 Barre Police Don/George Funded/Remove

George Driscoll briefed the Committee and recommended that the Committee remove the case from the Committee's docket as the contract has been funded by the Town.

Motion by Mazzarella, seconded by Andrews: to remove the case of Massachusetts Coalition of Police, Local 340 and the Town of Barre, JLM-23-10061, as the contract has been funded by the Town.

The Motion passed unanimously.

2. JLM-23-10115 Stoneham Fire Joe/Bob Funded/Remove

Bob Markel briefed the Committee and recommended that the Committee remove the case from the Committee's docket as the contract has been funded by the Town.

Motion by Cross, seconded by Mazzarella: to remove the case of Stoneham Permanent Firefighters IAFF Local 2116 and the Town of Stoneham, JLM-23-10115, as the contract has been funded by the Town.

The Motion passed unanimously.

3. JLM-24-10571 Springfield Supervisors Don/George Vote to 3(a)

George Driscoll briefed the Committee and recommended that the Committee vote the case to a 3(a) hearing.

Motion by Mazzarella, seconded by Bartolomei: that, in the matter of Springfield Police Supervisors Association and City of Springfield, JLM-24-10571, the issues have remained unresolved for an unreasonable period of time resulting in the apparent exhaustion of the process of collective bargaining, and that the Committee vote to hold a hearing pursuant to Section 1, subsection 3(a) of the Acts of 1987, with

panel members consisting of Perreira (Labor) and Mazzarella (Management) or other Committee members and/or senior staff that may be substituted as necessary by the respective Labor and/or Management Chairs pursuant to the rules, policies, and procedures of the Committee, and any other applicable provisions of law, with said panel to be chaired John Hanson.

The Motion passed unanimously.

4. JLM-24-10575 Holliston Police Don/Bob Jurisdiction

Bob Markel briefed the Committee and, based upon the investigation, recommended that the Committee take jurisdiction.

Motion by Andrews, seconded by Mazzarella: to take jurisdiction in the case of Holliston Police Association and Town of Holliston, JLM-24-10575.

The Motion passed unanimously.

Motion by Andrews, seconded by Mazzarella: to assign the following Committee Members to the case of Holliston Police Association and Town of Holliston, JLM-24-10575: Mazzucco (Management) and Perreira/Papandrea (Labor) or substitutes as so designated by the Management and Police Chairs respectively.

The Motion passed unanimously.

5. JLM-24-10590 Mansfield Fire Joe/George Jurisdiction

George Driscoll briefed the Committee and, based upon the investigation, recommended that the Committee take jurisdiction.

Motion by Mazzarella, seconded by Cross: to take jurisdiction in the case of Mansfield Firefighters, Local 1820 and Town of Mansfield, JLM-24-10590.

The Motion passed unanimously.

6. JLM-24-10599 Sharon Fire Joe/George Funded/Remove

George Driscoll briefed the Committee and recommended that the Committee remove the case from the Committee's docket as the contract has been funded by the Town.

Motion by Mazzarella, seconded by Cross: to remove the case of Sharon Firefighters Local 1880 and Town of Sharon, JLM-24-10599, as the contract has been funded by the Town.

The Motion passed unanimously.
