MEMORANDUM AND ORDER PURSUANT TO RULE 1:28

Based upon our review of the materials before the Superior Court judge, we conclude that summary judgment was correctly entered. As the plaintiff's conduct falls within the proscriptions of G. L. c. 268A, § 19, we accordingly affirm, for substantially the same reasons as those discussed in the commission's brief on appeal. We merely add an explanatory comment. There was sufficient evidence before the commission upon which it could properly base a determination that the plaintiff participated in a particular matter in such manner so as to violate the conflict of interest provisions of G. L. c. 268A, § 19.

Judgment affirmed.
