CONSENT ORDER

WHEREAS, pursuant to Massachusetts General Laws chapter 255E, and in accordance with the provisions of Massachusetts General Laws chapter 30A, the Commissioner of Banks issued an ORDER SUSPENDING MORTGAGE BROKER LICENSE, Docket No. 2011-046 (the "Suspension Order"), against JP Mortgage Group, L.L.C ("JP Mortgage Group" or the "Licensee") on July 6, 2011, based upon the failure of the Licensee to file timely reports, schedules, or applications, and/or to pay lawfully prescribed fees;

~~WHEREAS, The Division of Banks ("Division"), through the Commissioner, has jurisdiction over the licensing and regulation of persons engaged in the business of a mortgage loan originator in Massachusetts, pursuant to Massachusetts General Laws chapter 255E;~~

~~WHEREAS, COMPANY is, and at all relevant times has been, a Massachusetts licensed mortgage broker doing business in the Commonwealth;~~

WHEREAS, JP Mortgage Group filed a response to the Suspension Order whereby the JP Mortgage Group attested that it has discontinued the business of mortgage brokering in Massachusetts with the Division and attested that COMPANY and desires to surrender its the Massachusetts mortgage broker license;

WHEREAS, the parties now seek to resolve this matter by mutual agreement; and

WHEREAS, in recognition of the Division and JP Mortgage Group having reached the following mutual agreement under this Consent Order to resolve this matter, the Commissioner has terminated the Suspension Order on this ____ day of _____, 2011.

ORDER

NOW COME the parties in the above-captioned matter, the Division and JP Mortgage Group, and stipulate and agree as follows:

1. JP Mortgage Group attests that any and all officers, directors, managers, employees, independent contractors, and/or agents, operating on behalf of JP Mortgage Group, have ceased engaging in the activity of a mortgage broker in Massachusetts, as that term is defined under General Laws chapter 255E, section 1 attests that it has ceased engaging in the activities of a mortgage broker in Massachusetts, as those activities are defined under Massachusetts General Laws chapter 255E, section 1 and and the Division's regulation 209 CMR 42.00 *et seq.*, relative to any residential property in Massachusetts.

2. Immediately upon the execution of this Consent Agreement, the Division will update JP Mortgage Group's licensing status in Massachusetts in Nationwide Mortgage Licensing System (NMLS) to "Terminated- Surrendered/Cancelled."

3. To the extent that JP Mortgage Group wishes to resume business in Massachusetts as a mortgage broker at any time hereafter, JP Mortgage Group shall be required to submit a completed application to obtain the relevant license from the Commissioner. The Commissioner shall have all of the discretion set forth within General Laws chapter 255E, section 4 and the Division's regulation 209 CMR 42.00 *et seq.* in determining whether to issue a license to JP Mortgage Group to conduct the licensed business, provided however, that any such application shall not be denied solely on the basis of the Suspension Order.

4. The provisions of this Consent Order shall not limit, stop, or otherwise prevent any other state agency or department, from taking any other action affecting JP Mortgage Group.

5. This Consent Order shall become effective immediately upon the date of its issuance.

6. In accordance with the terms of the Consent Agreement entered by JP Mortgage Group and the Commissioner, JP Mortgage Group has waived all rights of appeal relative to the Temporary Order.

7. The provisions of this Consent Order shall remain effective and enforceable except to the extent that, and until such time as, any provisions of this Consent Order shall have been modified, terminated, suspended, or set aside by the Commissioner or upon an order of a court of competent jurisdiction.

8. This Consent Order and the Consent Agreement are the complete documents representing the resolution of this matter. There are no other agreements, promises,

representations, or warranties other than those set forth in this Consent Order, which replaces and supersedes all prior agreements between JP Mortgage Group and the Commissioner.
