# Background: CJ360 Cross Tracking Phased Approach



**In partnership with participating agencies and Google/SpringML, EOPSS and EOTSS planned a phased approach to develop the cross-tracking platform:**

- 1. January '21-August '22:** Established platform foundation, updated and standardized data intake across DOC and Sheriff Offices, and identified areas for data quality improvement
- 2. August-November '22:** Enhance platform capabilities to include recidivism reporting capability, refine data quality, and automate refresh of the data
- 3. December '22-December '23:** Full compliance with the Criminal Justice 2018 Reform Bill via expanded Criminal Justice Agency participation (including Trial Courts and Law Enforcement) and improved platform capabilities and analytics

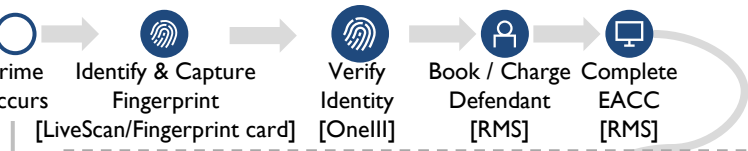
**With the CJ360 foundation now in place after last month's Phase I launch, EOPSS and EOTSS will look to participating agencies to:**

- Update data collection practices to comply with standard operating procedures
- Establish, monitor and report on metrics to track agency compliance
- Implement IT infrastructure updates and continuously transmit quality data into the new platform

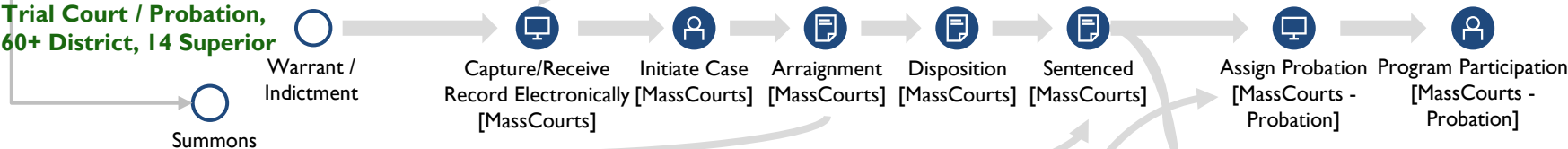

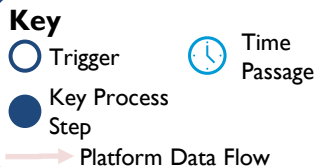


## Key Outcomes

- Publicly-available reporting for recidivism for rearraignment, reconviction and reincarceration tracked over 1-, 2- and 3-year periods and include categorizations by race, ethnicity, gender and age
- Ability to track individuals through criminal justice agencies with all criminal justice agencies and the judiciary using the SID assigned to each person who enters the criminal justice system
- Standardize methods of reporting and transmitting all required data (e.g., race and ethnicity) to facilitate assessment of the composition of the criminal justice population of the Commonwealth and make anonymized cross-agency data available to the public for analysis
- Active monitoring and reporting by participating agencies on compliance and increased use and electronic transfer of SID/OBTN across systems
- Access to internal dashboards with quality cross-agency data allows agencies to increase efficiency, collaboration and build data driven policy and operation decisions
