Jug End, from Resort to Refuge Saturday, Sept. 23, 1:00pm

Jug End Barn, perhaps the most famous and vibrant of the Berkshire recreational resorts from 1935-83, today a state park and wildlife refuge. The distinctive barn and features now gone, only scant traces remain, but memories of its heyday still resonate.

Join Nancy-Fay Hecker, daughter of Angus and Mimi MacDonald, long-time Jug End managers, and DCR State Park staff, Alec Gillman, for a leisurely two-hour tour of the former resort's significant sites, Jug End Barn, the Heritage House, the ski lodge and pro shop, the Guilder House, and its transformation back to nature, all in one of the region's most beautiful landscapes.

Be prepared for tall grass and vegetation - ticks are present. Recommended: comfortable but sturdy walking boots/shoes, appropriate clothing for weather, long pants, insect repellant, water and snack, and most important bring your memories of Jug End!



DIRECTIONS

Jug End State Reservation & Wildlife Management Area – approximately 116 Jug End Road, Egremont, MA. Take MA Rte. 23 to Egremont village. Take MA Rte. 44 south by Mill Pond, then immediate right onto Mt. Washington Road. Follow Mt. Washington Road for 1.7 miles, turn left onto Jug End Road. Follow Jug End Road for a half-mile; turn right at entrance and the parking lot. Call 413-442-8928 x134 for more information.
