MINUTES:

JOB DESCRIPTION FOR HEAVY EQUIPMENT OPERATOR:

Superintendent Matton stated the job has been posted as of 6/30/26. Discussion ensued about the interview committee. Chair Fagan agreed to be a member of the panel along with outside mosquito control personnel experienced in the job described and the license requirements.

FY26 BUDGET REVIEW:

Superintendent Matton provided the Commissioners with BCMCP's budget breakdown to date for FY26 and FY27. There are still invoices and payroll to process in FY26. It will be approximately September when the final roll over amount is determined. An updated breakdown will be provided at the next meeting with both FY26 and the beginning of FY27.

SRMCB MEETING REVIEW:

Commissioners Henry Vaillancourt, Christine Fagan, Derek Macedo, Joseph Carvalho and Greg Dorrance were in attendance. The SRMCB members approved Anvil 10+10 as the aerial product of choice if needed in 2026. Emergency response plan has been updated with no significant changes. A vote to continue the Jamestown Canyon virus testing with UMass and the CDC's New England Center for Excellence. Also, the addition of Leverett to Pioneer Valley mosquito control district.

FIELD UPDATE:

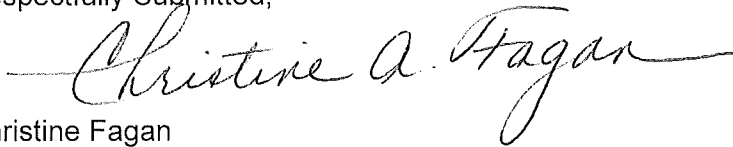
Entomologist Todd Duval continues to provide his weekly report via email. The weekly request call log was provided with comparison to 2024 and 2025. Drought conditions continue but rain events are creating Culex habitat. To date there have been 8 WNV detections in the state with none in Bristol. No EEE has been detected in the state. Superintendent Matton has continued with public outreach throughout the County.
