

MINUTES

July 25, 2022

A Hybrid Meeting of the Commissioners of the Cape Cod Mosquito Control Project (CCMCP) was held on July 25, 2022. In participation was: Superintendent Gabrielle Sakolsky-Hoopes, Assistant Superintendent Bart Morris, Entomologist Aubrey Paolino, Chairman J. Gregory Milne (remote), Vice-Chairman Rodney Collins (remote), and Commissioners Jim Quirk and Emily Beebe (remote).

Chairman Milne read the following remote meeting declaration:


'We are meeting remotely in accordance with An Act Relative to Extending Certain State of Emergency Accommodations ("Act"), which was signed by Governor Baker on July 16, 2022. This Act extends the expiration of certain provisions pertaining to the Open Meeting Law to March 31, 2023, allowing a public body to continue holding meetings remotely without a quorum physically present at a meeting location as long as it provides "adequate, alternative" access to remote meeting.'

Commissioner Quirk made a motion to approve the minutes of June 27, 2022. Motion 2nd by Vice-Chairman Collins and approved by way of roll call, with Commissioner Beebe abstaining due to being absent from that meeting.

Superintendent Sakolsky informed the Board that a pool of mosquitoes collected on Joint Base Cape Cod (JBCC) tested positive for WNV. The Project did inform JBCC of increased mosquito populations in their area. The drought status of the Commonwealth was also acknowledged, keeping most fresh water habitats dry.

Commissioner Beebe made a motion to appoint Jim Quirk as Assistant Secretary for the purpose of signing meeting minutes, 2nd by Vice-Chairman Collins and approved unanimously by way of roll call.

The next meeting was scheduled for August 29, 2022 at 2PM. There being no further business, Commissioner Quirk moved to adjourn, 2nd by Commissioner Beebe and approved unanimously by way of roll call.
