We are close to approaching the finish line of delivering an initial assessment to the Legislature on August 11! Thank you to everyone who has participated, contributed comments, presented, hosted a public hearing, testified at a public hearing, listened in, shared content for the final deliverable, and/or otherwise been involved in this expedited process—we really appreciate your involvement.

Three things:

1. The next **regular EVICC meeting is Thursday, July 27, 1–4:30 p.m.** and can be accessed via this Zoom link: <https://zoom.us/j/96819091328>. Attached is the official meeting notice and agenda and meeting minutes from June 29, 2023, with a few corrections some of you submitted. Thank you for taking a careful look at these...they're long, I know.
2. We have two public hearings coming up (official notice is attached and below): **Wednesday, July 26, 6–8 p.m. at Holyoke Community College** and **Wednesday, August 2, 2023, 6–8 p.m. at 100 Cambridge** (Saltonstall building) in Boston. This time we do have Zoom links set up for these and will be sure to tune in. Also attached are notes from the first public hearing, which was Wednesday, July 19, at UMass Dartmouth. Many thanks to Jamie Jacquart for his willingness to host!
3. We are diligently plugging in your content for the draft initial assessment into a master document and have a fairly tight timeline for turnaround:
 - Friday, July 28, noon — GreenerU to finalize text
 - Monday, July 31, EOD — EEA to review and deliver edits on text back to GreenerU
 - Tuesday, August 1, noon — draft initial assessment sent to EVICC
 - **Thursday, August 3, 1–3:30 p.m. — EVICC meeting: review and discuss draft initial assessment**
 - Friday, August 4 — GreenerU to make edits from meeting and start putting assessment into designed format
 - Monday, August 7 — GreenerU to finalize designed format and share with EVICC along with other meeting materials for August 9
 - **Wednesday, August 9 — EVICC meeting: finalize initial assessment**
