

MINUTES

July 28, 2025

A Hybrid Meeting of the Commissioners of the Cape Cod Mosquito Control Project (CCMCP) was held on July 28, 2025. In participation was: Supt.

Gabrielle Sakolsky-Hoopes, Assistant Superintendent Barton Morris, Chairman J. Gregory Milne, Vice-Chairman Rodney Collins, and Commissioners James Quirk and Emily Beebe. In addition, SRB Operations Coordinator Anita Amin, MDAR Legal Counsel Jessica Burgess and Chair of the Cape Cod Conservation District Mark Forest were also in participation.

The following remote meeting declaration was read into the minutes:
Cape Cod Mosquito Control Project Board of Commissioners is Meeting remotely pursuant to legislative authorization extending the remote meeting provisions of the Open Meeting Law through June 30, 2027, as signed into law by Governor Healey on March 28, 2025.

Vice-Chairman Collins made a motion to approve the minutes of June 24, 2025. Commissioner Beebe 2nd the motion and it passed by way of roll call with Commissioner Quirk abstaining due to being absent from that meeting.

Cape Cod Conservation District Chairperson Mark Forest gave a presentation on the proposed Bayview Bogs Restoration Project which will return abandoned cranberry bogs back to wetlands.

A discussion was held on how the Project handles public information requests. MDAR Legal Counsel Jessica Burgess shared the process and expectations when such requests are received.

Commissioner Beebe departed the meeting at this time.

Supt. Sakolsky updated the Board on surveillance findings as well as field conditions, notably the increase in salt water mosquitoes coming from the Cape Cod National Seashore (CCNS) in Eastham which prompted CCNS to issue a permit for larvicide treatment in limited select areas.

The next meeting was scheduled for August 25, 2025 at 2PM.

There being no further business, Commissioner Quirk made a motion to adjourn, 2nd by Vice-Chairman Collins and approved unanimously by way of roll call.
