


June Precipitation & Departures



Precipitation


Accumulated Precipitation (inches) June 01, 2025 to June 30, 2025

Departure from Normal (inches)


3 and 6 Month Percent of Normal



Last 3 Months (Apr-Jun)

- Near or above normal for most of MA
- Near to below normal for Cape/Islands (80-120%, 60-80% for Nantucket)


Precipitation Percent of Normal April 01, 2025 to June 30, 2025



Last 6 Months (Jan-Jun)

- Mostly near normal (80-120%)
- Outer Cape/MVY: 60-80%
- Nantucket 40-60%

Precipitation Percent of Normal January 01, 2025 to June 30, 2025




7 Day Precipitation Forecast

Through Tuesday July 15th (Includes July 8th Precip)

Boston/Norton MA

- I-2" for central and east/southeast MA
- 0.25 I "for central/western MA
- Locally higher amounts expected in T-Storms

10 Day High End/Low End Forecast Precipitation Amounts


- 100 Forecast Models
- ~90 predict I0 Day QPF 0.3-0.7"


- 100 Forecast Models
- ~10 predict 10 Day QPF 2-2.5"




Outlook: July 13th - July 17th



Odds favor above normal precipitation and above normal temperatures








Leaning Above Normal Precipitation


Above Normal Temps Likely




Outlook for July, Aug, Sep

Above Normal Temperatures Likely








Latest River Forecasts

No river flooding anticipated during the next ten days.

- A 52 member ensemble run for all NERFC forecast points to give us an idea of the possible range of river flows out 10 days.

Boston/Norton MA WEATHER FORECAST OFFICE

<u>June:</u>

- Departures ranging from 1.5 to 3 inches below normal
- Below Normal Precipitation for most of Massachusetts

Longer Range Precipitation Departures:

- 3-month and 6-month departures near or above normal for most of the state
- Sections of Cape and Islands still below normal (40-80% of normal)

Outlook:

- 0.25" (central/western MA) to 2 (east/southeast MA)" of new precipitation possible through next Tuesday
- Leaning toward above normal precipitation through the end of July
- Equal Chances for above/below normal precipitation through September
