

MINUTES

June 27 2022

A Meeting of the Commissioners of the Cape Cod Mosquito Control Project (CCMCP) was held on June 27, 2022. In participation was: Superintendent Gabrielle Sakolsky-Hoopes, Entomologist Aubrey Paolino, Chairman J. Gregory Milne, Vice-Chairman Rodney Collins, and Commissioner Jim Quirk.

The Board discussed the potential change in Open Meeting Law legislation regarding remote participation.

Vice-Chairman Collins moved to approve a 4% COLA increase for all active CCMCP employees, effective July 3, 2022. Motion was 2nd by Commissioner Quirk and approved unanimously by way of roll call.


The Board considered the current Commissioner stipend rate. There are no changes recommended at the time.

The Board reviewed the most recent Scope of Services from the UMASS Collins Center.

Superintendent Sakolsky informed the Board of the recent SRB Meeting in which spray opt-outs was discussed, as well as votes taken after procedural and product reviews.

In the field, dry conditions are decreasing mosquito habitats. Crews are focusing on treating catch basins and salt water mosquitoes.

The next meeting was scheduled for July 25, 2022 at 2PM. There being no further business, Vice-Chairman Collins moved to adjourn, 2nd by Commissioner Quirk and approved unanimously by way of roll call.
