

MINUTES

June 28, 2021

A Meeting of the Commissioners of the Cape Cod Mosquito Control Project (CCMCP) was held on June 28, 2021. In participation was: Superintendent Gabrielle Sakolsky-Hoopes, Assistant Superintendent Barton Morris, Entomologist Aubrey Paolino, Vice-Chairman Rodney Collins, Commissioners Jim Quirk and Emily Beebe, and Secretary Arthur Neill. Chairman J. Gregory Milne joined after agenda item #2.

Commissioner Beebe made a motion to approve the minutes of May 18, 2021, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Secretary Neill. The motion was approved by way of roll call with Commissioner Quirk abstaining due to his absence from that meeting.

Superintendent Sakolsky updated the Board on the Mosquito Control for the 21<sup>st</sup> Century Task Force listening session review held on June 2, 2021. Next task force meeting is scheduled for July.


Superintendent Sakolsky informed the Board that since mid-May, 2 historic trap sites in Wellfleet are catching record numbers of mosquitoes. The area is owned by Cape Cod National Seashore (CCNS) who does not allow mosquito control activities on this property. Superintendent Sakolsky has been in constant communication with CCNS to obtain a special permit for access and treatment.

The Board was updated on field, personnel and COVID matters.

Commissioner Quirk made a motion to allow for the continuation of either in person or hybrid meetings until further notice. Motion 2<sup>nd</sup> by Vice-Chairman Collins and approved unanimously by way of roll call.

The next meeting date is set for Monday, July 26, 2021 at 2:00PM.
