




May Precipitation & Departures

Precipitation

Accumulated Precipitation (inches) May 01, 2025 to May 31, 2025



6-10" inch totals for most of the Commonwealth3-6" inches for Cape/Islands

Precipitation Departure from Normal (inches) May 01, 2025 to May 31, 2025


Central/Western MA: 2-6 inches above normal East/Southeast MA: 2-4 inches above normal

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2nd Wettest May for Worcester (Green Line)






3 and 6 Month Percent of Normal

Last 3 Months (Mar-May)

- Well above normal for central MA (120-160%)
- Above normal for western/eastern MA (100-140%)
- Near to slightly below normal for Cape/Islands (80-120%, 60-80% for Nantucket)





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



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Last 6 Months (Dec-May)

- Mostly near normal (80-120%)
- Worcester County above normal (120+%)
- Outer Cape: 60-80%
- Nantucket 40-60%










Average Temperatures for May

Generally within I degree of normal



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
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7 Day Precipitation Forecast

Through Sunday June 15th


- 0.5 to 1" forecast through Sunday evening
- Locally higher/lower amounts expected
- Highest confidence in precipitation is for Tuesday
- Additional precipitation possible next weekend





Outlook: June 14th - June 18th

Odds favor above normal precipitation and below normal temperatures



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
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Outlook: May 17th – May 30th

No strong signal for above/below normal precip




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55-60% chance for above normal temperatures














Outlook for Jun, July, Aug

Odds favor above normal precipitation and above normal temperatures through July

Summary

<u>May:</u> Near normal temperatures and Well Above Normal Precipitation

- Departures ranging from 2 to as much as 6+ inches above normal
- Only Nantucket was below normal (0.5" below normal)

Longer Range Precipitation Departures:

- 3-month and 6-month departures near or above normal for most of the state • Sections of Cape and Islands below normal (40-80% of normal)

Outlook:

- 0.5 to 1" of new precipitation possible through next Sunday
- Leaning toward above normal precipitation for the second week of May
- Odds favor above normal precipitation through August



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
