## NOTICE TO PROBATIONER

If fines, fees, costs, and/or civil penalties have been assessed as indicated on this form, you have the right to ask the court to modify this order if you can show that paying it will cause a substantial financial hardship to you, your immediate family or your dependents.

- You may be found in default
- A warrant may issue for your arrest.
- Additional fees may be assessed.
- You may be committed to jail.

## HOW TO PAY

### To Pay In Person:

Pay at the Clerk-Magistrate's Office of this court with a money order, bank check, VISA or Mastercard, or cash. (Most courts do not accept personal checks.)

### To Pay By Mail:

Mail a money order or bank check made payable to "The Commonwealth of Massachusetts" to the clerk's office. Include on the money order or bank check your date of birth and docket number of the case (listed on the front of the form for which you are making payment). The clerk's mailing address can be found at [mass.gov/orgs/district-court/locations](http://mass.gov/orgs/district-court/locations).

### To Pay Online:

Payments may be made online via ePay at [www.masscourts.org](http://www.masscourts.org). This requires a valid email address and the full 12 digit Docket number assigned to your case listed on the front of this form. The first two digits are the year, the second two identify the court division, and after "CR" is the case number. Add zeros before the case number until there are a total of six digits. Note: There is an extra fee to pay online.

*Payment must be **received** at the Court by the date the payment is due.*

If payment is not received when due, you must appear in court to avoid arrest.

## PROBATION COMPLIANCE CREDITS

Your probation term may be reduced after one year of compliant probation supervision if your probation follows a sentence of incarceration and your probation is not for a sex offense as defined by G.L. c. 6, § 178C. G.L. c. 276, § 87B.
