Proposed Action	Non-Major Comprehensive Plan Approval
Purpose:	Operation of mineral processing operations at the P.J. Keating Company Acushnet quarry. The Non-Major Comprehensive Plan Application addresses facility mineral processing, including rock crushing, screening, and conveyance to allow for up to 7.38 tons of particulate matter emissions per consecutive 12-month period. The facility's asphalt production operations will remain unchanged.
