Dear Mr. Collins:

I represent the Massachusetts Division of Insurance (“Division”) with regard to the above-captioned investigation. The Division has investigated Keith Collins, Inc. (“KC”) writing insurance policies after its insurance producer license expired.

According to Division licensing records, KC was originally licensed by the Division in 2005. The insurance producer license expired on or about December 27, 2017.


The Division alleges that KC wrote, placed, renewed and/or negotiated 13 policies from December 27, 2017 to July 5, 2018. The Division alleges that KC committed no less than 13 violations of M.G.L. c. 175, § 175 by acting as an insurance producer without being licensed. The penalty for each and every violation of M.G.L. c. 175, § 175 is a fine of not more than \$100. Each violation of M.G.L. c. 175, § 175 is also a violation of M.G.L. c. 175, § 162R(a)(2), the penalty of which is a fine of no more than \$1,000 and/or license suspension, probation or revocation.

The Division proposes to resolve this matter through a settlement if KC agrees to waive its right to a hearing in this matter, agrees to cease and desist from the above-alleged conduct and to pay a fine of **\$750**. This will be a reportable administrative action. If KC chooses to accept the Division’s offer, please sign this settlement letter where provided below and return it to my attention, together with a check made payable to the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, no later than March 7, 2019.


Although this correspondence does not constitute the required statutory notice of a public hearing, if this matter is not resolved by March 7, 2019, the Division intends to file an Order to Show Cause.
