I. Conservative Care:

A. Not Applicable

II. <u>Clinical Findings</u>:

- A. Subjective (Pain alone is not an indication)
 - 1. Instability of the knee; described as "buckling or giving way"; and
 - **a.** Significant effusion at time of injury; and/or
 - b. Description of injury indicates a rotary twisting or hyperextension occurred

AND

- **B.** Objective
 - 1. Positive Lachman's sign
 - **2.** Supportive findings:
 - a. Positive pivot shift; and/or
 - **b.** Positive anterior drawer; and/or
 - **c.** Positive KT 1000, > 3-5 mm = +1 > 5-7 mm = +2 > 7 mm = +3

AND

- **C.** Imaging Positive findings with:
 - 1. Arthrogram; or
 - 2. MRI; or
 - 3. Arthroscopy
