Laptop: Monitor Ports  
(HP ProBook 400 G5 and G6)

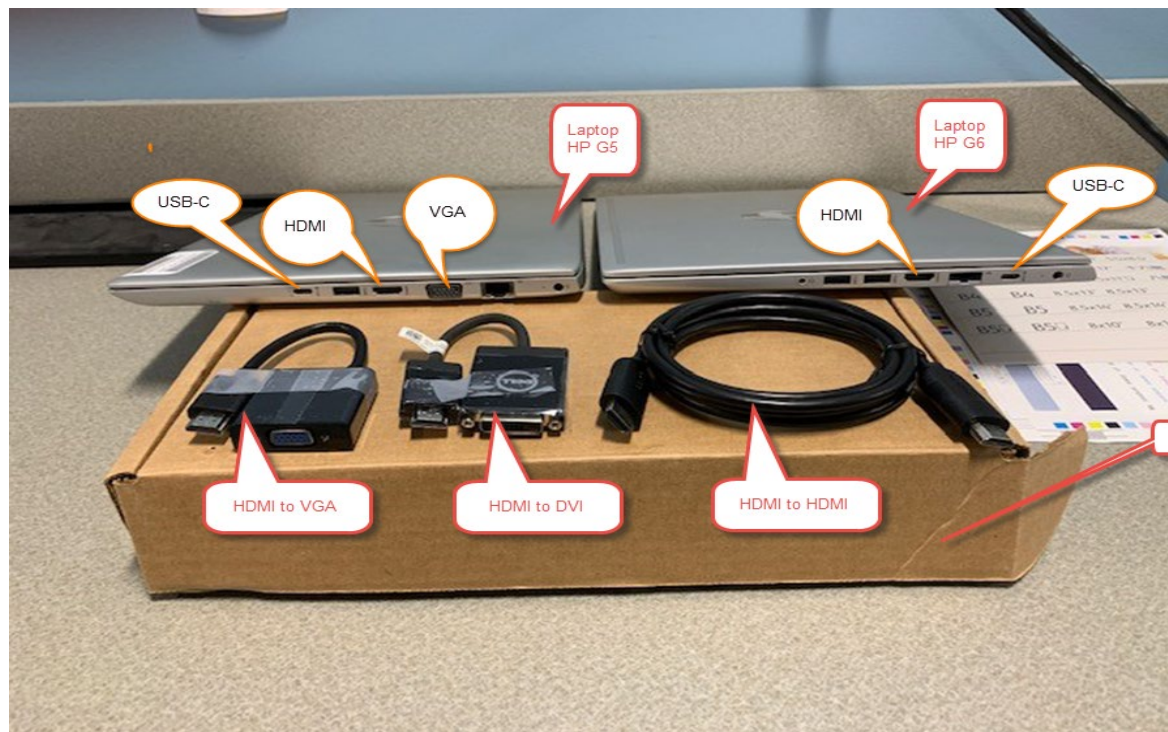
**Summary:**

The following is an explanation of the monitor ports available for the HP ProBook 400 G5 and G6.

Laptop monitor ports connect external monitors that can mirror or extend the laptop's display.

The HP ProBook 400 G5 and G6 provides several port options. Determining which option to use will depend on the ports available on the external monitor being connected. Additionally, external monitors may offer multiple port options to utilize. Only one option should be chosen per external monitor.

**USB-C Port:**

Not a common port option on monitors. Does not support audio feed to monitors.

The USB-C port is also utilized by other devices.

**HDMI Port:**

A common port option on monitors. Supports both video and audio.



<b>VGA Port:</b>	A common port option on monitors. Supports both video and audio.
<b>NOTE:</b>	<p>Some larger HD monitors only support DVI or DisplayPort ports. It is recommended that an HDMI to DVI or HDMI to DisplayPort adapter is utilized.</p> <p>Retailers that offer such adapters include Best Buy, Staples, CDW, and Micro Center. Bringing the laptop and a photo of the monitor’s port options to the retailer will clarify your needs to a sales associate.</p>
