114 Liquors, Inc. dba 114 Liquors (the "Licensee") holds an alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c. 138, §15. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission (the "Commission") held a hearing on Tuesday, September 25, 2012, regarding an alleged violation of 204 CMR 2.05(2), to wit: c.138, §34- Sale or Delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one (21) years of age. Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the licensee stipulated to the violation alleged in Investigator Bailey's Compliance Check Field Report.

FACTS

- 1. On Wednesday, May 9, 2012, at approximately 7:53 p.m., Investigators Doyle and Bailey conducted an investigation of the business operation of 114 Liquors, Inc. dba 114 Liquors.
- 2. An underage operative working with investigators purchased an alcoholic beverage, one (1) forty ounce (40 oz.) bottle of Budweiser beer for three dollars (\$3.00). The underage operative was not asked for identification.

CONCLUSION

Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the licensee violated of 204 CMR 2.05(2), to wit: c.138, §34- Sale or Delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one (21) years of age. Therefore, the Commission suspends the license for three (3) days of which three (3) days will be held in abeyance for a period of two (2) years provided no further violations of Chapter 138 or Commission Regulations occur.
