

SOLAR CANOPY ACCOMPLISHMENTS

- MBTA: 2 MW
- MetroWest Regional Transit Auth.: 198 kW
- Military Division: 205 kW
- Roxbury Community College: 937 kW
- UMass Amherst: 4.8 MW
 UMass Boston: 664 kW*
 UMass Lowell: 201 kW

50% of the 28 MW of solar PV installed or under construction at state facilities are solar canopies. These installations are estimated to generate over 16 million kWh annually, equivalent to the electricity used by 2,154 Massachusetts homes.
