FY23 Annual Tracking Form Guidance

<u>Executive Order 594 requires the Leading by Example Program (LBE)</u> to be responsible for "tracking and collecting building and vehicle energy consumption, clean energy development, GHG emissions, and other relevant information associated with state government operations." Furthermore, LBE must "report annually on progress toward meeting the targets and objectives of the Order.

The Executive Order officially applies to "all executive branch agencies and all public institutions of higher education," while quasi-independent authorities are encouraged to fully participate in efforts to meet the Order's goals. The Order also states that "[a]gencies will provide energy consumption data and other information as requested by LBE" to support compliance with these tracking and reporting requirements.

The remainder of this document specifies the state entities for which LBE tracks a range of data as well as some of the specific data needs from different entities. If you have any questions on the reporting process, please reach out to Sophia Vitello at sophia.vitello@mass.gov.

For the following entities, LBE generally collects data on **natural gas, grid electricity, fuel oil (heating oil and diesel), gasoline, and propane** consumption, as well as information about fleet vehicles. However, LBE still encourages these agencies to provide any of this data that is available through the <u>Annual Tracking Form</u>. However this data is obtained, LBE staff will work to review it with each entity's staff to ensure its accuracy. Additionally, LBE is requesting that these same entities report all other data requested in the tracking form, such as EV charging station deployment, planned energy projects, sustainable landscaping programs, and other sustainability efforts, etc.
