**DECISION**

**GLOBAL MONTELLO GROUP CORP. D/B/A CONVENIENCE PLUS #2750

Global Montello Group Corp. d/b/a Convenience Plus #2750 ("Licensee") holds an alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c. 138, § 15. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission ("ABCC" or "Commission") held a remote hearing via Microsoft Teams on Tuesday, July 23, 2024, regarding an alleged violation of 204 CMR 2.05 (2) Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: M.G.L. Ch. 138, § 34 Sale or Delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one years of age. Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the Licensee stipulated to the facts alleged in Investigators Guarino & Fleming's Minimum Purchase Age Compliance Check Field Report.

The following documents are in evidence:

1. Investigators Guarino & Fleming's Minimum Purchase Age Compliance Check Field Report, 4/1/2024;
2. ABCC Local Licensing Authority Review Record, Transfer of License Approved 1/31/2017;
3. Licensee's Stipulation of Facts.

There is one (1) audio recording of this hearing.

**FINDINGS OF FACT**

1. On Monday, April 1, 2024, at approximately 6:32 p.m., Investigators Guarino and Fleming ("Investigators"), conducted a compliance check at Global Montello Group Corp. d/b/a Convenience Plus #2750.
2. An underage operative, working under the supervision of Investigators, purchased an alcoholic beverage, one 24-ounce can of Bud Light beer for three dollars (\$3.00). The underage operative was not asked for identification.
3. The Licensee has held a license under M.G.L. c. 138, § 15 since 2017 with no previous violations.

CONCLUSION

Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the Licensee violated 204 CMR 2.05 (2) Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: M.G.L. Ch. 138, § 34 Sale or Delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one years of age. As a result, the Commission issues a **WARNING**.
