- People of all sexual orientations and gender identities
- Immigrants, refugees, and undocumented persons regardless of legal status

PRIVACY


- Are you concerned about your private information?
- Do you need help protecting your confidential information or records in a legal or disciplinary proceeding?
- Do you have social media concerns?

SAFETY

- Do you feel unsafe at home, work, and/or school?
- Are you being harassed or contacted by the perpetrator?
- Are you experiencing stalking?

EDUCATION

- Are you having trouble going to middle school, high school, or college?
- Is the perpetrator a part of your school community (i.e., a student or employee)?



IMMIGRATION

- Are you worried about your immigration status?
- Are you concerned about your legal rights as an immigrant, refugee, or undocumented person?



HOUSING

- Do you feel unsafe where you live?
- Do you need help breaking a lease?



EMPLOYMENT

- Are you having trouble working?
- Did you lose your job, or get harassed or disciplined at work?



FINANCIAL STABILITY

- Do you have unpaid bills?
- Do you need public benefits or victim compensation?
