The Human Resources Division (HRD) has received and reviewed your town's request to exempt position(s) from M.G. L. c. 31.

HRD has conducted a review for compliance with Section 285 of Chapter 238 of the Acts of 2024. It is confirmed that your town had legislation filed with the general court between January 4, 2023 and July 31, 2024 to remove any or all positions within a police department for your town and also submitted a letter to the personnel administrator of the division of human resources within the executive office for administration and finance, the joint committee on public service and the chair of the civil service commission before February 15, 2025 indicating that your town still seeks such exemption from said chapter 31.

Please consider this to be official notice from HRD that the following title: Police Chief for the Leicester police department is exempted from MGLc.31, as of March 1, 2025.
