DECISION

O'BRIENS MARKET INC. DBA O'BRIEN'S MARKET 84 MAIN STREET LENOX, MA 01240 LICENSE#: 060200037

O'Briens Market Inc. dba O'Brien's Market (the "Licensee") holds an alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c. 138, §15. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission (the "Commission") held a hearing on Tuesday, June 10, 2014, regarding an alleged violation of 204 CMR 2.05 (2) – Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: c. 138, §34 – Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one (21) years of age. Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the licensee stipulated to the violation alleged in Investigator Keefe's Report.

The following documents are in evidence:

1. Licensee's Stipulation of Facts; and

Investigator Keefe's Investigative Report dated March 6, 2014.

There is one (1) audio recording of this hearing.

FACTS

- On Thursday, March 6, 2014 at approximately 3:48 p.m., Investigators Kujawski and Keefe conducted an investigation of the business operation of O'Briens Market Inc. dba O'Brien's Market.
- 2. An underage operative, working with investigators, purchased an alcoholic beverage, an India Pale Ale beer (Berkshire Co.) for four dollars and eighty five cents (\$4.85). The underage operative was not asked for identification.

CONCLUSION

Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the licensee violated 204 CMR 2.05 (2) – Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: c. 138, §34 – Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one (21) years of age. As the licensee has been in business for more than ten (10) years and has had no previous violations, the Commission issues a **WARNING**.
