Dear Ms. Bickelman:

We appreciate the willingness of you staff to meet with our office recently to discuss the \$5.5 million procurement of 108 vehicles by the Massachusetts Bay Transportation Authority (MBTA) using American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) funding. As you know, the MBTA purchased the vehicles under a department procurement conducted by Massachusetts Department of Transportation (MassDOT) formerly the Executive Office of Transportation. Our review of this MassDOT procurement is part of our on-going effort to monitor ARRA expenditures.

The MBTA made these purchases from contract no. 2008DRAV, awarded by MassDOT in early 2009. Our review of the procurement revealed several issues in which the Operational Services Division (OSD) has jurisdiction under 801 CMR 21. We therefore requested and OSD agreed to review the procurement process for contract no. 2008DRAV. The following are the key issues we brought to your attention:

- Contract specifications may not have been developed per OSD guidelines.
- Overly restrictive and inconsistent specifications may have restricted competition.
- Inconsistent answers to bidders' questions during the process may have restricted competition.
- The proposal evaluation process did not conform to OSD policy by failing to use a quantitative scoring system to evaluate bids.
- Delivered vehicles did not meet contract specifications.
- Recordkeeping for the procurement process may not have conformed to OSD guidelines.

Thank you again for agreeing to review this procurement. If we can be of any further assistance please do not hesitate to contact our office. We look forward to the results of your review.
