DECISION

Chip Shots Pub, Inc. dba Chip Shots Pub

Chip Shots Pub, Inc. dba Chip Shots Pub (the "Licensee") holds an all alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c. 138, §12. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission (the "Commission") held a hearing on Tuesday, September 27, 2011, regarding an alleged violation of M.G.L. c.138, §34. Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the licensee stipulated to the violation alleged in Investigator Brad Doyle Compliance Check Field Report.

2. Compliance Check Field Report dated July 25, 2011.

FACTS


1. On, July 25, 2011 at approximately 6:46 p.m., Commission Investigators investigated the business operation Chip Shots Pub, Inc. dba Chip Shots Pub.
2. An underage operative, working with the investigators, purchased a bottle of Bud for three dollars and seventy-two cents (\$3.72). The underage operative was not asked for identification.
3. Administrative review of the licensee's files indicates this was the first violation by the licensee since being licensed in 2010.

CONCLUSION

Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the licensee violated M.G.L. c. 138, §34. Therefore, the Commission **suspends the license for three (3) days of which three (3) days will be held in abeyance for a period of two (2) years provided no further violations of Chapter 138 or Commission Regulations occur.**


