## **DECISION**

George Davis dba Tedeschi #481 12 Jennifer Street Littleton, MA 01460 License #: 062400011 Heard: September 27, 2011

George Davis dba Tedeschi #481(the "Licensee") holds an all alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c. 138, §12. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission (the "Commission") held a hearing on Tuesday, September 27, 2011, regarding an alleged violation of M.G.L. c.138, §34. Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the licensee stipulated to the violation alleged in Investigator Brad Doyle's Compliance Check Field Report.

The following documents are in evidence:

1. Licensee's Stipulation of Facts; and

2. Compliance Check Field Report dated July 25, 2011.

There is one (1) tape of this hearing.

## **FACTS**

 On, July 25, 2011 at approximately 6:46 p.m., Commission Investigators investigated the business operation George Davis dba Tedeschi #481.

2. An underage operative, working with the investigators, purchased a bottle of Bud for two dollars and twenty-four cents (\$2.24). The underage operative was not asked for identification.

3. Administrative review of the licensee's files indicates this was the first violation by the licensee in nine (9) years of business.

## **CONCLUSION**

Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the licensee violated M.G.L. c. 138, §34. Therefore, the Commission suspends the license for three (3) days of which three (3) days will be held in abeyance for a period of two (2) years provided no further violations of Chapter 138 or Commission Regulations occur.
