**DECISION**

**THREE G'S AND J., INC. DBA COMMON CONVENIENCE**  
**5 STEVENS STREET**

Three G's and J., Inc. dba Common Convenience (the "Licensee") holds an all alcohol license issued pursuant to Massachusetts General Laws chapter 138, §15. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission ("the Commission") held a hearing on Tuesday, September 20, 2011, regarding an alleged violation of M.G.L. c. 138, §34. Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the licensee stipulated to the violation alleged in Investigator Brad Doyle's Compliance Check Field Report.

1. Licensee's Stipulation of Facts; and
2. Compliance Check Field Report of Investigator Brad Doyle.

**FACTS**


1. On, July 25, 2011 at approximately 7:49 p.m., Commission Investigators investigated the business operation Three G's and J., Inc. dba Common Convenience.
2. An underage operative, working with the investigators, purchased a can of Budweiser Can for two dollars and fifty-four cents (\$2.54). The underage operative was not asked for identification.

**CONCLUSION**


Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the licensee violated Massachusetts General Laws c. 138, §34. The Commission **suspends the license for three (3) days of which three (3) days will be held in abeyance for a period of two (2) years provided no further violations of Chapter 138 or Commission Regulations occur.**
