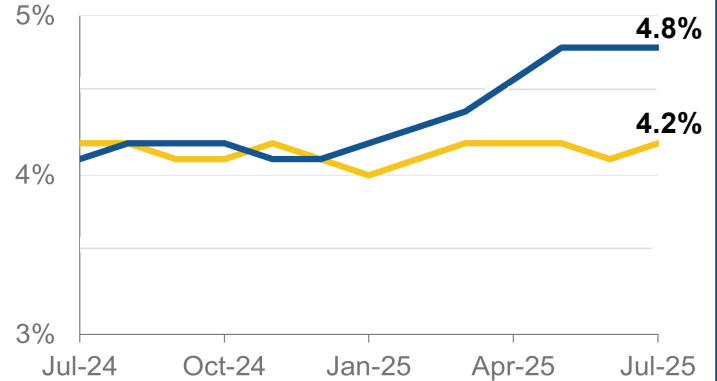

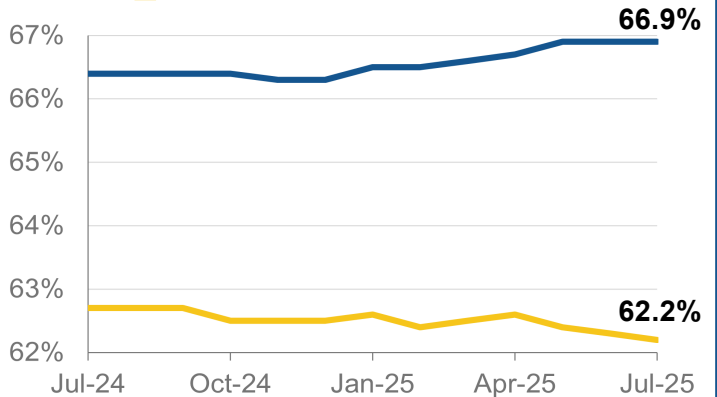
Unemployment Rate
