

1st Year September 1, 2022 - \$1.40 March 1, 2023 - \$1.40

2nd Year September 1, 2023 - \$1.40 March 1, 2024 - \$1.40

3rd Year September 1, 2024 - \$1.40 March 1, 2025 - \$1.40

4th Year September 1, 2025 - \$1.40 March 1, 2026 - \$1.40

The following breakdown of the new Wage and Benefits contract between the New England Mechanical Contractors Association and the Plumbers & Pipefitters Local 4 are listed below. The new rates will be in effect from September 1, 2022, through February 28, 2023.

<u>All</u> Pension benefits are to be submitted to the National Pension Fund along with the International Training Fund monies.

APPRENTICES

ALL apprentices receive Health & Welfare.

International Training Fund is to be paid on ALL apprentices.

Year 1-3 Apprentices do NOT receive National Pension and Annuity

Year 4 - 5 Apprentices do NOT receive National Pension, but <u>DO</u> receive Annuity

Wages payable under the apprentice program shall be as follows upon the recommendation of said joint committee, unless the same shall be amended by agreement:
