At 1:05 p.m. J. Hellen called the meeting to order and welcomed Lt. Governor Driscoll and other cabinet officials in attendance. J. Hellen asked for LGAC members on the call to introduce themselves. J. Hellen then accepted a motion to adopt the minutes of the September 10, 2024 meeting, which was unanimously adopted as noted above. The Executive Committee then met as noted above.

Then the full LGAC resumed its meeting and covered the items on the agenda: a presentation from the Secretary of Administration & Finance on the state's current fiscal year revenue collections and a prospective budget outlook; a presentation from the Executive Office of Climate Innovation & Resilience with an update on the work of the office with a focus on efforts of particular interest to local governments; and a presentation from the Federal Funds & Infrastructure Office (FFIO) on the recently passed federal funds legislation which provides both technical assistance funding and matching funds for cities and towns pursuing federal funding opportunities. There were no votes or decisions on any of these items. Speakers during the meeting included J.Hellen, K. Williams, M. Tarsi-Goldfein, R. Fuller, J. Mangiratti, N. LaChapelle, M. Nicholson, C. Hoyt, LG Driscoll, M. Gorkowicz, J. Schrag, and Q. Palfrey.
